The Celebrant at the Eucharist was P. Rakotozafy, Provincial of the Company of Jesus, and two of his brother priests, P. Jean Romain Rafanomezantsoa and P. Oliver Rasolofoniaina. It was a festive Mass in honour of the Baptism of Jesus.



Since some of the major Superiors were not Ignatian, Sister Melanie, Regional Superior of the Congregation of Saint Joseph d'Aoste introduced the organisation and running of this time of formation.





The group presented the name of the course: « IRAKA » and the « logo » which explains it's aims.

This time, the number 8 is very significant: 8 trainees, 8 different Congregations, the 8th group of participants, their chosen Word of God is Mt5, 3-11: the eight beatitudes.

In his turn, P. Jean Romain, used a flow chart diagram to present all those who collaborate in the smooth running of the FSI from the general level to the teaching staff and the support staff.

Then P. Fulgence Rakotozafy expressed his joy at being able to participate in this meeting and to be involved through his brother priests, P. Jean Romain our Superviser and P. Oliver who is receiving us into the Centre of Ignatian Spirituality. He also introduced us to an important time which the Company of Jesus is living through now:

- 125 years since the martyrdom of James Berthieu
- 50 years of the growth of the Jesuit Province in Madagascar

- The 4 apostolic priorities for the Company of Jesus asked for by Pope Francis.

To achieve all of this the Jesuits in Madagascar are organising a program, not just to celebrate but, above all, to establish a special time of evangelisation which will touch the different age groups in society.

They have taken as their motto, « To renew all things in Christ. »

We are agreed that collaboration will have plenty of space.
